

# Shiloh Baptist Church Food Pantry and Clothes Closet

## Eligibility Requirements

**\*\*\*\*ALL INFORMATION WILL REMAIN CONFIDENTIAL\*\*\*\***

If you are applying for assistance from **THE FOOD PANTRY**, you must supply the following items:

### **The client needs to bring the following:**

- Letter of referral, if client was referred by an agency. (Letter is retained in THE Food Pantry Records)
- Proof of the number of people in the household (SS card)
- Address documentation-utility bill, Driver's license, etc.

### **Any one of the following list can be acceptable evidence of income:**

- Current paycheck stub
- 1040 Forms
- A letter from employer stating gross wages
- Copy of award letter from Social Security Administration
- Copy of unemployment letter or check stub

**Automatic qualifier - clients that participate in these programs are income eligible. They should show some form of program identification in one of the following programs:**

- Temporary Assistance to Need Families (TANF)
- The Food Stamp Program
- Supplemental Security Income (SSI)
- Women, Infants, and Children (WIC)
- Medicaid
