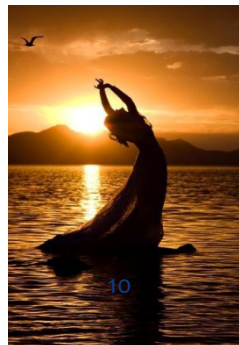

Statement

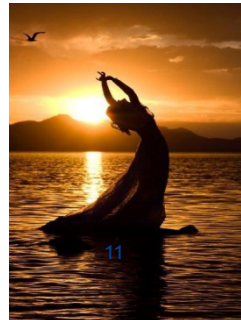
From Confident and Sunny Hours to Life's Experiences of Darkness, Disappointment, Discouragement, Despair and then to the Good that follow trials.
